Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents 2 to 4 to inquire into the matter in detail with reference to the allegation that the death of the son of the petitioner was not an accident but was an outcome of the rivalry. Putting forth these details, petitioner had submitted a representation dated 05.08.2017 (Annexure P-4) to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar-respondent No.3 which was followed by another representation dated 02.02.2018 (Annexure P-5) but no action thereon has been taken.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider the representations of the petitioner, referred to above, and thereafter proceed in accordance with law.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, present petition is disposed of with directions to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar-respondent No.3 to look into the representations dated 05.08.2017 and 02.02.2018 (Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively) of the petitioner and if some substance is found therein, further action in accordance with law be taken.
