DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The dispute in the present case is of the signatures of the deceased i.e. father of the complainant and that objection was never raised during his lifetime. The complainant is disputing not only the signatures but there is difference of amount also. The matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre but it could not be settled. The allegations are matter of evidence, which shall be tested by the trial Court.

Since in compliance of order dated 29.5.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and the offence is triable by Magistrate, interim order dated 29.5.2018 passed in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
