Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the very fact that the MLR as regards the injuries on the petitioner is dated 08.07.2017, it is not the fault of the petitioner and other co-accused that the police did not register even the cross version to the FIR till 25.07.2017, the MLR in respect of the injuries on the complainant in the FIR being of 10.07.2017, showing fresh bleeding on the wounds.

That being so, and the learned State counsel already having submitted on the last date of hearing that the petitioner had joined the investigation, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, (either the FIR or the cross version thereto), the order dated 23.01.2018, admitting the petitioner to bail, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
