AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 224 dated 23.04.2018 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar, District Hisar.

It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is the sole beneficiary of the Will, which has been executed in his favour by the mother of the petitioner and, therefore, there was no reason why the petitioner would have resorted to bringing any people by impersonation on behalf of his brother and two sisters for execution and registration of the said deed, on which an enquiry was conducted by Joint Sub-Registrar, Hisar. He further contends that the petitioner is ready and willing to join investigation and co-operate with the same as the present case is purely based on documentary evidence.

Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the

petitioner and keeping in view the fact that he is unable to give an affidavit of the brother and two sisters of the petitioner that they were the persons who have stood there and executed the deed at the time of registration of the deed, the stand of the petitioner cannot be accepted. Custodial interrogation of the petitioner would be essential to find out the persons who have impersonated and appeared at the time of registration of the documents.

The present petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
