The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.62 of 28.04.2017, under Sections 498-A, 354, 377, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women, Jhajjar.

It is submitted by counsel for the parties that during the pendency of these proceedings, the matter has been compromised between the parties on 05.12.2017 before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the petition in hand stands allowed. In the event of

arrest, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
