The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.188 dated 14.06.2016 registered under Sections 307, 326, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana City, on the basis of compromise dated 17.06.2016 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that although Section 307 IPC is involved in this case but the compromise was entered into within four days of the incident. The parties are residing in the same locality and in case FIR is quashed it shall promote peace and harmony.

Pursuant to order dated 10.11.2016, report dated 13.02.2017 has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana. According to this report, statements of the parties have been recorded and that the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at without any threat or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the FIR No.188 dated 14.06.2016 registered under Sections 307, 326, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana City, and all the consequential proceedings

having arisen therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
