Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners were accused in case FIR No.123 dated 09.09.2017 under sections 307/364/452/506/323/148/149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act and (Section 302 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kulgari, Distt. Ferozepur and they have not faced the trial. Co-accused of the petitioners have been acquitted by the trial Court.

Petitioners have approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail in the aforesaid FIR in view of judgment dated 11.04.2018, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur, whereby the main accused have been acquitted.

In case the same evidence is there against the present petitioners also, that is to be seen by the trial Court. Petitioners are directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of one month from the

date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case they surrender and move application for regular bail, the trial Court is directed to decide the same within a period of two weeks thereafter in accordance with law.

No ground is made out for anticipatory bail.

Dismissed with aforesaid directions.
