In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 of Cr.P.C in case FIR No.69 dated 16.05.2018 registered under Sections 452/323 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

2. Petitioner was granted the benefit of interim bail vide order dated 29.05.2018 and directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ram Singh submitted that Section 452 IPC is stated to have been deleted. Rest of the Sections are relating to Sections 323 and 325 IPC which are bailable.

4. Accordingly, order dated 29.05.2018 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
