The reply submitted by the State is accompanied with an affidavit dated 04.07.2017 submitted by the petitioners, wherein they have stated as under:-

“That now, no police protection is required by us and the application which were submitted by myself Narinder Kaur and Sikander Khan against above said

Maninder Singh, Harmanpreet Singh and Amarjit Kaur, we do not want any action on that application. Now, we both, with our will and wishes are residing in Village Dehliz Kalan, Tehsil Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.”
