The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.41 dated 26.3.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 452, 427, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and 25 and 27 Arms Act at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, District Gurdaspur.

Status report by way of affidavit of Suba Singh, PPS, Superintendent of Police (Investigation), Batala has been filed in Court today which is taken on record.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the injury has

been attributed with datar on the person of Rashpal Singh but there is no medical record. It is Rashpal Singh who has self-suffered the injury.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that Rashpal Singh is not medically examined.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 29.5.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
