Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioners who submits that absence of his clients in the Ld. Trial Court was squarely attributable to their Ld. Counsel, who neither informed them nor took appropriate steps to appear before the Ld. Trial Court on the concerned date, on account of which coercive processes ultimately resulting into Proclaimed Offender orders being passed against them.

In view of the grounds mentioned in the application, the matter at this stage is disposed off with the direction upon the petitioners to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court on or before the

next date fixed before it and seek fresh bail, and also to pay adjournment cost of Rs.10,000/- to the complainant's side directly in the Ld. Trial Court.
