In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail in case FIR No.89 dated 06.10.2017, under Sections 302/148/149/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala.

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that alleged role of the petitioner is limited to the extent that petitioner was accompanied with the main accused like Mahinder Singh, Gurdeep Singh @ Soni and others in respect of the crime. She is under custody since 7.10.2017. It was also submitted that petitioner is a widow having 2 children.

3.) *Per contra*, learned counsel for the State while resisting the contention of the petitioner submitted that *challan* and charge-sheet have been filed. Now matter is listed for the purpose of examination of the

witness.

- 4.) Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
- 5.) Perusal of the FIR, it is evident that petitioner's role is limited to the extent that she is accompanied with the main accused like Mahinder Singh, Gurdeep Singh @ Soni and others. Except that no specific allegations have been made against the petitioner to the extent of causing any injury to the dead person or any other person.
- 6.) In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail, therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sandeep Kaur is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned with the following condition:-

- (i) Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and she shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.
