Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438

Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.50 dated 17.03.2018, registered under Section 13/2 of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, at Police Station Bichhor, District Nuh.

The FIR was registered on the basis of secret information on the allegation that two cows and one ox having their mouths and legs tied were being taken away by the petitioner.

Now the petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovery from him.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 29.05.2018, passed by this Court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands allowed.
