This order shall dispose of CRM-M-22534 of 2017 and CRM-M-22347 of 2017. For the sake of convenience, facts are extracted from CRM-M-22534 of 2017.

Petitioner-Bohar Singh, is the husband and petitioner Rajinder Kaur, is the mother-in-law of the complainant.

Both the petitioners seek the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.71 dated 26.04.2017, under Sections 406, 498-A, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Faridkot. District Faridkot.

It is informed that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties during the pendency of this petition. Petitioner-Bohar Singh and his wife have decided to part ways. It is agreed that a total sum of

₹50 lakhs in two installments shall be handed over to the complainant in lieu

of all her claims; past, present and future in respect to the maintenance, dowry, Istridhan, alimony etc. A petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, shall be filed. Petitioners undertake to abide by the terms and conditions of the settlement in letter and in spirit. It is thus prayed that these petitions be allowed.

Petitioners as well as respondent no.2 duly identified by their counsel are present in Court. They affirm that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. The complainant submits that she has no objection in case both these petitions be allowed subject to the petitioners strictly adhering to the terms and conditions of the settlement.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, affirms and verifies that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not involved in any other criminal case.

Photocopy of agreement dated 06.03.2018 filed in Court today is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, but without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, these petitions are allowed. Consequently, order dated 22.06.2017 in CRM-M-22534 of 2017 and order dated 20.06.2017 in CRM-M-20.06.2017, are made absolute.

It is clarified that none of the observations made hereinabove shall be construed to be a reflection on the merits of the case. The same are solely confined for the purpose of decision of the present petitions.
