Prayer in the second instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner Mohan in case FIR No.233 dated 10.03.2017 under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Jind, District Jind.

According to the prosecution, 235 gram of heroin has been recovered from the petitioner.

Custody certificate filed in Court today is taken on record.

As per custody certificate, the petitioner has been booked in six more cases apart from this case, out of which in two cases, he has already been convicted on 30.01.2018 and 10.03.2009; in two cases, he has been acquitted and in rest of the cases, he is facing trial.

Considering this aspect of the matter, the petitioner does not deserve any concession of bail.
