Pursuant to the order dated October 31, 2018, an affidavit of Sh.Jaswinder Singh Chahal, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Industrial Area-B, Ludhiana, has been filed in Court today by the learned State counsel, in which it is stated in paragraph 3 that the record of ownership of the land owned by the petitioner, as submitted through the record of rights (*jamabandi*) produced in Court on the last date of hearing, has been verified and found to be correct.

The petitioner is found to be owning land measuring 2 *bighas* and 2 *biswansis* (fully described in the affidavit), situated at village Badalthuha, Tehsil Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. That being so, and the petitioner now having remained in custody for 1 year and about 3 months, with the complainant in the FIR stated to have been examined as per learned State counsel (on instructions from ASI Jagir Singh) and 31 witnesses still remaining to be examined, I

consider it appropriate to admit him to bail, upon him furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, which shall ensure that the bonds so furnished are of a sufficiently adequate amount, to try and sure that the petitioner does not jump bail.
