Petitioner-Poonam Saini has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.414 dated 08.05.2018, registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat, under Section 420 IPC and Sections 101 (D) and 103(G) of the Trade Marks Act, 1999.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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As per the allegations in the FIR, the present petitioner and her husband were operating salon in the name of Headmasters Studio at Angel Mall, HUDA Sector 11, Panipat. As per the allegations, an agreement to operate the branch of Headmasters Studio in Panipat was signed by the present petitioner alongwith her husband, but they did not pay the dues and accrued royalties.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 30.05.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from her. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending her to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 30.05.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
