AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioners that three times investigation has been carried out in FIR No.114 dated 15.09.2011 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 302/34 IPC at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, but two times, the same has not been accepted and further again the cancellation report has been submitted on 20.08.2015 before the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, which is still pending without any order by the said Court. Counsel contends that the petitioners, when the FIR was registered against them, were juvenile but now have attained majority and have participated in the selection process for appointment to a public post. Since they have cleared the requisite tests and have to submit their verification certificate from the police authorities, because of the pendency of the cancellation report, the police is unable to give them a clearance certificate, which is ultimately going to result in losing their appointment and also becoming overage. Counsel thus submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioners to, at this stage, withdraw the present petition to

file an appropriate application before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sultanpur Lodhi, which may be directed to be considered and decided at an early date.

In view of the above facts and circumstances as narrated by the counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the cancellation report is submitted on 20.08.2015, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file an application before the Court for passing appropriate orders at an early date.

In case such an application is filed, the same shall be entertained.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
