Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners Talwinder Singh alias Talwinderpal Singh and Surinderpal Singh in case registered by way of FIR No.86 dated 06.05.2018 at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran under Sections 452, 323, 336, 341, 342, 506, 354, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act.

The present petition qua petitioner No.2-Surinderpal Singh stood dismissed as not pressed vide orders dated 30.05.2018 on the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 30.05.2018 qua petitioner No.1 Talwinder Singh alias Talwinderpal Singh passed by this Court, the said petitioner ha joined investigations which is not controverted by

learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurbaksh Singh, Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran who submits that the said petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to petitioner No.1 Talwinder Singh alias Talwinderpal Singh vide order dated 30.05.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
