KULDIP SINGH J. (Oral)

Present petition was filed for protection of life and liberty on the ground that the petitioners have married against the wishes of their parents. Both of them claimed that they have become major.

Learned State counsel states that an FIR under Sections 363 and 366 IPC has already been registered against the petitioner No.1 on the ground that petitioner no.1 is major, whereas petitioner no.2 is 16 ½ years old.

On the last date of hearing, none has appeared for the petitioners. Same is the position today as well.

As such, the present petition is dismissed for want of prosecution. However, State is at liberty to investigate the FIR registered against petitioner no.1 in accordance with law.
