The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.77 dated 28.04.2018 under Sections 306 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

2. This Court vide order dated 30.05.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions states that in pursuance to the order dated 30.05.2018 the petitioner has joined investigation. That apart observations made by this Court in the order dated 30.05.2018 have gone un rebutted.

4. In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 30.05.2018, granting ad-

interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
