In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.67 dated 10.05.2018 registered under Section 61/1/14 of Excise Act at Police Station District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that there were certain disputes between the petitioners and 1st petitioner's wife with one Goldy Chahal (Liquor Contractor) and Bagga Singh, ASI, Giddarbaha. In this regard, wife of petitioner No.1 submitted complaint on 8.6.2017. During pendency of the complaint, in order to harass the petitioners and 1st petitioner's wife FIR has been registered on 10.05.2018.

3. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

4. Having regard to the nature of allegations made by the petitioner with reference to Annexure P-2 read with FIR (Annexure P-3), petitioners are entitled to anticipatory bail.

5. Accordingly, Petitioners are directed to join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, they shall be released on pre-arrest anticipatory bail by the Investigating

Officer on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition is allowed accordingly.
