KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner Jagroop Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 309 dated 30.11.2017, registered under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station City Khanna, District Khanna.

Affidavit of custody dated 6.6.2018 filed by learned State counsel in Court today is taken on record. As per the said custody certificate, petitioner is in custody for the last four months and nine days. The allegations against the petitioner is that complainant, who is an NRI, had assigned his route permit to General Transport Company and the said company illegally sold it to the present petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that all the offences are triable by the Magistrate.

Since the challan has been presented and the disposal of the trial will take time, therefore, there is no ground for further detention of the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court /Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
