Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.206 dated 08.7.2015, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 56, Gurugram, on the basis of compromise vide order dated 22.3.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 31.5.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 09.10.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram has submitted her report vide letter bearing No.982 dated 17.10.2018 duly

forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Gurugram vide letter No.2320/C-29 dated 20.10.2018.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with their free will.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram, dated 17.10.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.206 dated 08.7.2015, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 56, Gurugram is hereby quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh; ₹1,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and ₹5,000/- with the High Court Legal Services Authority, within a period of two weeks' from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
