Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.91 dated 02.06.2016, registered under Sections 304-B/34 of IPC at Police Station Sadar, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the private witnesses which are 04 in numbers, namely, Harjinder Kaur, Narinder Singh, Daljit Singh and Angrej Singh have been examined and they have not supported the prosecution version. Counsel states that copies of the statements of 03 witnesses have been placed on record and he does not have copy of the statement of Angrej Singh.

Counsel states that the petitioner is in custody since 09.08.2016.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
