The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.1 has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Abhay Pal Singh Gill, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner No.1 is a divorcee and has placed on record the photocopy of the judgment dated 12.03.2018 passed by the Additional District Judge, Amritsar granting ex parte decree of divorce in favour of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at this stage, has

submitted that a representation dated 24.05.2018 was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka and the Station House Officer, Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka (Annexure P5) seeking necessary protection but no action has been taken so far in the matter.

Heard.

Without examining the question of validity or otherwise of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka and the Station House Officer, Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka to look into grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation (Annexure P5) and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances.
