By invoking Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, “Cr.P.C.”), the petitioner has prayed for quashing of complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, summoning order dated 5.8.2008 and order dated 26.5.2014 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the entire amount has been paid and the matter has been settled.

Vide order dated 10.1.2018, the parties were relegated to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court to explore the possibility of amicable settlement.

During the concilation, the parties amicably settled their dispute vide agreement/settlement dated 17.1.2018.

In view of the above and the fact that the the entire amount has

been paid and the matter has been settled between the parties, the complaint filed by the complainant has become infructuous, the present petition is allowed and complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act including summoning order dated 5.8.2008 and order dated 26.5.2014 are hereby quashed.
