Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.11 dated 14.01.2018 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420 and 177 IPC at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana as well as other consequential proceedings arising thereto in view of compromise dated 14.05.2018 (Annexures P-3).

2. Pursuant to order dated 30.05.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 15.06.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.299, dated 04.07.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, vide letter No.559/EC dated 05.07.2018.

3. According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is

genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with their free will.

4. Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, dated 04.07.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.11 dated 14.01.2018 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420 and 177 IPC at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana, is quashed.
5. Petition is disposed of accordingly.
