This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for taking action against respondents No.5 to 7 as they had forcibly and illegally taken the possession of vehicle bearing registration No.PB05-M-9947, Chassis No.447207MT2320153 Make Tata LPS 4018.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned authorities to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka respondents No.3 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-8) within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. He is further directed to submit status report before concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. and others**; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.
