Through this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC the petitioner prays for quashing criminal complaint No.10 dated 16.01.2003 (Annexure P-1) and judgment dated 09.10.2006 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dasuya (Annexure P-2) and for staying the proceedings before the learned Appellate Court, Hoshiarpur.

In compliance of order dated 06.08.2018, the demand draft bearing Nos.719331 and 719332 dated 30.08.2018 amounting to ₹ 30,000/- each has been handed over by learned counsel for the petitioner to learned counsel for the respondent. Receipt of the same has been acknowledged by learned counsel for the respondent by signing the photocopy of the same. Same be taken on record.

In view of no objection from learned counsel for the

respondent, the complaint No.10 dated 16.01.2003 titled as Sant Ram gupta vs. Darshan Singh and the judgment dated 09.10.2016 passed by SDJM, Dasuya (Annexure P-2) are quashed.

The amount, if any, deposited by the petitioner before the Appellate Court, Hoshiarpur is ordered to be reimbursed to the LRs of respondent in accordance with law against proper receipt and identification.
