The learned State counsel, in terms of last order, passed by this Court, has stated at bar that total weight of 400 tablets came to 48 grams and 50 grams is commercial. Therefore, recovery is non commercial.

It comes out that petitioner was granted interim bail by trial Court on 12.4.2016 (Annexure-P-2), as report of laboratory was not received at that time. He jumped bail on 11.5.2018 and his bail was cancelled by trial Court. As petitioner had appeared before trial Court and on his appearance, he stands admitted to bail, therefore, interim bail granted by this Court on 31.5.2018, is made absolute. The trial Court is at liberty to initiate proceedings against petitioner under Section 446 Cr.P.C. Petition is allowed.
