DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.(ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.286, dated 18.11.2017, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case whereas he was not a party to the agreement to sell. Petitioner never met the complainant Ajit Singh being a student of B.Com final in the year 2018. Petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case. The father of the petitioner was in need of money and borrowed amount from his brother-in-law. The loan amount to the tune of Rs.3 lacs was given. Petitioner is in custody since 07.03.2018 and even a single witness has not been examined so far after framing of charges. The offence is triable by Magistrate and may take sufficient time to conclude.

Petitioner is not having any criminal background as there is no other case pending against him.

Learned State counsel has not opposed the stage of the trial; custody period as well as pendency of no other case against the petitioner but opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage.

Heard arguments of learned counsel for the parties and have also perused the contents of the FIR and other documents on the file.

Keeping in view that the petitioner is in custody since 07.03.2018; the offence is triable by Magistrate and also the fact that petitioner is a student; no other criminal case is pending against him and even a single witness has not been examined so far, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
