In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.52/2008 dated 12.04.2018, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana.

2. Perusal of the allegations, it is evident that it is a case cheating of money of the complainant. Matter requires custodial interrogation as recovery of amount cheated and other documents are yet to be effected.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Satpal Singh submitted that petitioner is also involved in similar type of cases relating to cheating to other person.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, petitioner is not entitled to concession of anticipatory bail.

5. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
