The petitioners are seeking direction to official respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members as they have been threatened by respondent No. 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioner No. 1 is a widow and petitioner No. 2 and 3 are her sons. Learned counsel contends that although the Civil Court has granted permanent injunction to the petitioners but respondent No. 5 with the help of the local police is harassing and pressurizing them to part with the property. He has drawn my attention to the representation dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure P-6) sent to respondent No. 3 in this regard. Learned counsel contends that the petitioners will be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to look into their representation dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure P-6).

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ropar Range,

Ropar, Punjab to look into the representation dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioners and take steps to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of petitioners and their family members.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
