The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.052 dated 16.3.2018 (Annexure P1) under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Division No.2, Ludhiana along with the consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 28.5.2018 (Annexure P2).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana received. Statements of the both the parties have been recorded. It is reported that the parties have compromised the matter. Compromise is out of free will and without any inducement or pressure from the accused person. Offences are under Section 420 and 120B IPC regarding allegedly getting money to sent the daughter of the complainant abroad.

Since, the matter has been compromised, FIR No.052 dated 16.3.2018 (Annexure P1) under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at

Police Station Division No.2, Ludhiana along with the consequential proceedings stands quashed qua the petitioners.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
