Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.467 dated 24.12.2015 (Annexure P-1), registered under Sections 279 and 337 IPC, at Police Station Sector 26, Chandigarh, in the light of the compromise which has been entered into between the petitioner and respondent No.2-Surinder Parkash Dhiman, who is present in Court.

The matter was earlier compromised on 26.05.2017 (Annexure P-2), however, there was dispute with regard to the payment of the amount, leading to the matter being referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The matter has been finally settled and the petitioner has paid an amount of ₹25,000/- by way of demand draft in Court today to Surinder Parkash Dhiman, who has received the same in Court and stated that he has no objection to the prayer made in the present petition being allowed.

Keeping in view the fact that a compromise has been entered into between the parties and that complainant-respondent No.2 has no objection to the quashing of the FIR and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, the present petition deserves to be allowed in the light of Full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*** as also the judgment of Supreme Court in ***Narinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab 2014 (2) RCR (Criminal) 482***.

Ordered accordingly.

FIR No.467 dated 24.12.2015 (Annexure P-1), registered under Sections 279 and 337 IPC, at Police Station Sector 26, Chandigarh, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed.
