In the present petition, petitioners seek anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.66 dated 08.04.2018 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City, Patti, District Tarn Taran.

2. This Court vide order dated 30.05.2018 had directed the petitioners to join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Santokh Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 30.05.2018 the petitioners have joined investigation. That apart observations made by this court in the order dated 30.05.2018 have gone un rebutted.

5. In view of these factual aspect and circumstances, without

expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 30.05.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. However, the petitioners shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and they will also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial. This order would not come in the way of his custodial interrogation in any other matter.

7. Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
