Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.46 dated 24.03.2018 registered under Sections 435, 427 of IPC at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the complainant is not a registered owner of the car and, therefore, has no locus to register an FIR. He further states that since the matrimonial dispute is between the petitioner and daughter-in-law of petitioner No.2-Gurmeet Singh and the daughter-in-law is being represented by Mr. Mandeep Sharma, petitioner has unnecessarily been named, for which, they have submitted a representation to the Superintendent of Police.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent that in case, petitioner submits a representation to the Superintendent of Police concerned, the same shall be considered by the respondent in accordance with law.
