Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conclude the investigation in FIR No.104 dated 20.04.2012 under Sections 406, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar City and submit the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

Reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, West, Amritsar City filed in the Court today, is taken on record and as per this affidavit, on the basis of enquiry conducted by the Additional Commissioner of Police, Traffic, Amritsar and Assistant Commissioner of Police, West, Amritsar, cancellation report was prepared on 09.05.2013 and was submitted before the Illaqa Magistrate but the same was not accepted and re-investigation was ordered. It is further stated in the affidavit that thereafter, on an application

given by the petitioner, re-investigation was conducted by Additional Commissioner of Police, City-2, Amritsar and again a final cancellation report dated 09.11.2018 has been prepared and approved by the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kirpal Singh, submits that the cancellation report will be submitted before the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of six weeks from today.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered as infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a complaint/protest petition, if so advised.
