AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging that no action has been taken against the named persons in the FIR, although two unknown persons have already been arrested but their test identification parade has also not been carried out.

Counsel contends that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 25.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, for proper investigation of the case in FIR No.62 dated 01.05.2018 registered under Sections 307, 452, 34, 120-B IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib. He further states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib-respondent No.3, to look into the representation of the petitioner and take action in accordance with law.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib-respondent No.3, to look into the representation dated 25.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) submitted

by the petitioner and if some substance is found therein and the assertions are found to be correct, action be taken in accordance with law.
