Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the respondent authorities to register an FIR under the relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code or any other law, on the basis of complaint dated 05.01.2018.

Reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zira District Ferozepur, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 filed in the Court is taken on record.

As per the reply, an enquiry was conducted on the application given by the petitioner – Vinod Kumar and after recording the statement of all the concerned persons, the enquiry report was submitted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zira District Ferozepur.

It is further stated in the affidavit that, thereafter, the petitioner never moved an application and later on, the petitioner had executed an affidavit that he has no objection if, the Bank recovered the loan amount by way of selling the truck and the Bank has sold the truck

and has even filed a civil suit against the petitioner, which is pending in the Civil Court at Ludhiana. It is also stated that in the proceedings initiated under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, the petitioner stands convicted for a period of one year and a fine of Rs.50,000/- was also imposed.

In view of the above, no further action is required.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of.
