JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 31 dated 02.05.2016 under Sections 363, 366-A IPC and Section 376 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station, Sadar Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matter has been been compromised between the parties.

While issuing notice of motion, this Court stayed the arrest of the petitioner. However, by order dated 16.01.2018, this Court was pleased to direct the trial Court to get recorded the statements of the parties regarding genuineness of the compromise. In pursuance thereto, a report has been received from the Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur, that the parties have compromised the matter and the same is without any pressure or threat.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State confirms the factum of compromise between the parties.

Since the parties have compromised the matter, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 06.07.2017 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation; will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
