In the present petition, petitioners seek anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No. 66 dated 01.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) u/s 452, 324 and 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

Allegations against the petitioners are that they have attacked the complainants while entering the complainants relatives house that too at about 11 pm. Perusal of the MLR dated 30.03.2018 it is evident that there were 6 injuries. Injuries No.1 to 3 are sharp and Injuries No. 2, 4, 5 and 6 are pointed sharp. In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioners are not entitled for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
