The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.29 dated 29.3.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Heard.

It is the allegation against the petitioner that he allured the people to deposit the money in M/s Vihaan Direct Selling Private Limited, Bangalore.

Counsel for the petitioner also submits that in fact the family members of the petitioner also deposited money in the bank account of M/s

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 31.5.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
