In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 of Cr.P.C in case FIR No.75 dated 04.05.2018 registered under Sections 307/452/148/149/506/427 IPC at Police Station Punjab Agriculture University (PAU) District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

2. Petitioners were granted the benefit of interim bail vide order dated 1.6.2018 and directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jagtar Singh submitted that pursuant to the order dated 1.6.2018, petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

4. Accordingly, order dated 1.6.2018 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
