Prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner Jagga Singh in a case arising from FIR No.133 dated 27.08.2017 under Sections 324/323/34 IPC and later on added Sections 325/326 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Ferozepur.

According to the prosecution, the petitioner is facing trial in the aforesaid FIR on the allegations that he gave two kappa blow on the head of injured Wajir Singh, which have been declared grievous in nature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that there is cross version case between both the sides. The petitioner also received simple injuries from the hands of complainant party, who is also facing trial under Section 323 IPC for causing injuries to him. The petitioner is in custody since 04.02.2018. Conclusion of trial may take a long time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
