The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in case DDR No. 26 dated 03.08.2017, registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC in FIR No. 146 dated 02.08.2017, under Sections 326, 323, 452, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 01.06.2018, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there was a sudden fight between two sides, in which the petitioners also suffered injuries. Counsel for the petitioners has relied upon MLR of both the petitioners (Annexure P-1 colly.) to submit that the petitioners have suffered injuries and a cross-version case was registered in the aforesaid FIR. It is further submitted that since it is a case of version and cross-version, it is to be seen during the trial, as to which party was aggressor party and which party acted in selfdefence. Learned counsel for the

petitioners further submits that during the investigation, three persons were found innocent and co-accused, who is attributed injury under Section 307 IPC, has been arrested.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 01.06.2018, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Gurpreet Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 01.06.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
