The present second petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.67 dated 23.7.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Banur, District Patiala.

Notice of the petition.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Abhay Pal Singh Gill, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Earlier the petitioner has filed CRM-M-5513-2018 which was dismissed being not pressed on 23.4.2018. The second petition has been presented on 30.5.2018.

It is the case of the prosecution that the petitioner has inflicted

two injuries with knife in the abdomen of the complainant which were found to be grievous and dangerous to life. The investigating agency wants to recover the weapon of offence.

To the mind of this Court, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary, therefore, he is not entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
