1. Affidavit of Mr. Mandhir Singh, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa filed on behalf of respondent No.3 today in Court, is taken on record.
2. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to get the matter investigated into the allegations levelled in the representation dated 21.03.2018 (P-6), moved by the petitioners inasmuch as respondents No.5 to 8 had committed fraud with them.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No. 3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa (Punjab), is directed to decide representation (P-6), moved by the petitioners.

4. In view of the above, respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa (Punjab), is directed to look into the matter and decide representation dated 21.03.2018 (P-6), moved by the petitioners, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to them, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

5. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
