Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite FIR No. 206, dated 27.05.2016, having been registered at Police Station Bhupani, District Faridabad, no action thereafter has been taken by the police.

He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no. 2, i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, to go into the grievance of the petitioner in terms of the representation made to him on 26.05.2016, a copy of which has been annexed with the petition as Annexure P-2 and to take a decision thereon within a specified period.

Consequently, without going into the merits of the contentions made in the petition, in any manner whatsoever, respondent no. 2, i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, is directed to go into the matter and to take a decision as per law, on the representation of the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
